| <b>FINALGROUP</b><br><b>Gideon, Barrak, Sampson, Jephthah, David, Samuel, prophets (List all they are collectively known for doing by faith)</b><br>(32-39)Conquered kingdoms; Administered justice; Shut mouth of lions; Quenched the fiery flames; Escaped the edge of the sword; Weakness turned to strength; Powerful in battle | None   | Raised people from death; tortured; imprisoned; lived as poor; persecuted; mistreated | None  | -Believed & loved God.<br><br>-Greater gain with God.  |
